Lahsen khabar is a distinguished State Doctor in Mycology and Professor at Mohammed V University- Faculty of Sciences in Rabat, Morocco. He leads "Mycologie Forestière et Trufficulture" research team, focusing on controlled mycorrhization for desert truffles and truffles to combat desertification. Khabar teaches forest mycology and truffle culture at the same Faculty.

He is member of several networks, including the OPTIMA group's Mycology commission, the Mediterranean "Mycoludesme" network, and the "Terfess" network. Khabar also belongs to the "TAUESG" Group and serves on the IWEMMs organization and scientific committees.

As the founder and president of the Moroccan Association for the Protection of Terfess and Other Edible Mushrooms, "TerfAss", Khabar has organized several congresses, including HYPOGES1 and HYPOGES2.

He has published books and chapters, such as "Terfess and Truffles in Morocco" and "Desert Truffles", along with numerous scientific articles on Terfess and truffles.
